Where the Department of Environment are currently assessing the Banksia Road proposal and the associated environmental impacts, we can make our biggest impact here as it is the least progressed mining approvals process.
2. State Government  
Ministers have the power to have both the Banksia Road and Boomerang Road proposals reassessed under Section 43 of the Environmental Protection Act. They also demonstrated the ability to withdraw approvals entirely for ROE8.
